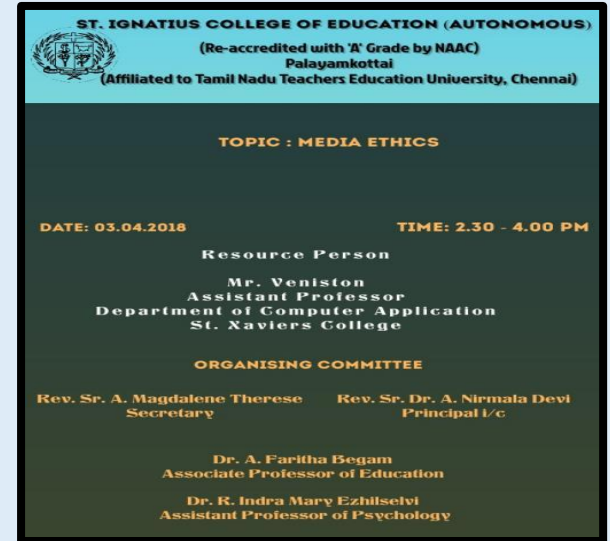
# BABBAGE COMPUTER ASSOCIATION
