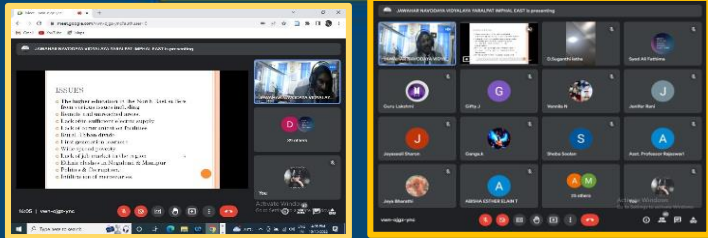

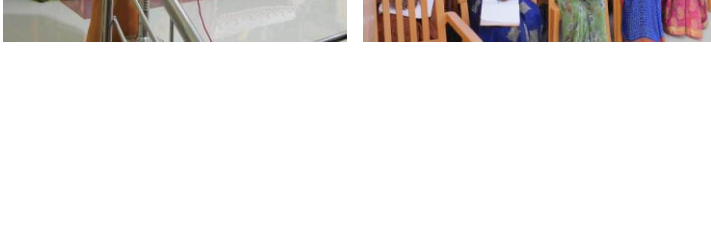


Invited Talks

On 10th November 2022 Number Ninjas Clun organized a field visit to Head Post Office, Palayamkottai.



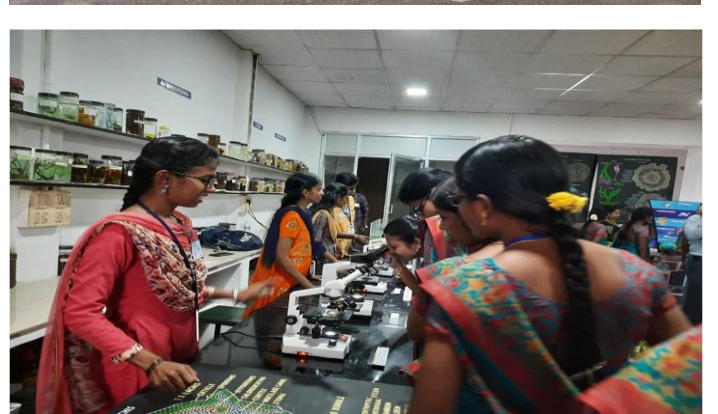
