In addition, M.Ed. scholars are expected to prepare a reflective report on scholastic and non-scholastic activities of the supporting schools, any one of the Teacher Education Institutions, a Special School and DIET that are engaged in developing innovative curriculum and pedagogic practice, educational policy planning, educational management and administration.
