- Student teachers are required to always exemplify punctuality and discipline,
 embodying the motto "Virtue is our Strongest Shield" in their actions and behaviour.
- Uphold moral and ethical principles, embodying the ICM charism "Passion for God and Compassion for God's People," recognizing your responsibility as members of this esteemed institution.
- Attendance is compulsory and integral to internal assessment. Student teachers must maintain regular attendance in all classes, remedial sessions, class tests, and examinations on all working days across both semesters.
- Adhere strictly to the college schedule, attending all classes, meetings, and events on time. Late arrivals or early departures should be avoided unless permitted.
- Obtain permission before leaving the classroom during class hours, ensuring respect for the teaching-learning process.
- Always adhere to the college dress code, reflecting professionalism and respect.

 the Identity Card and uniform saree must be worn during Internship and Extension
 Activities.

- Make use of the library and laboratories responsibly, adhering to the prescribed schedule and under the guidance of staff.
