



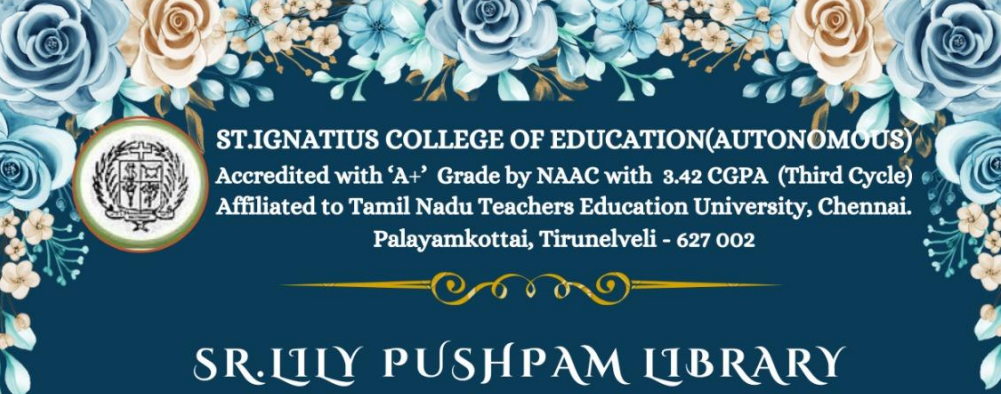

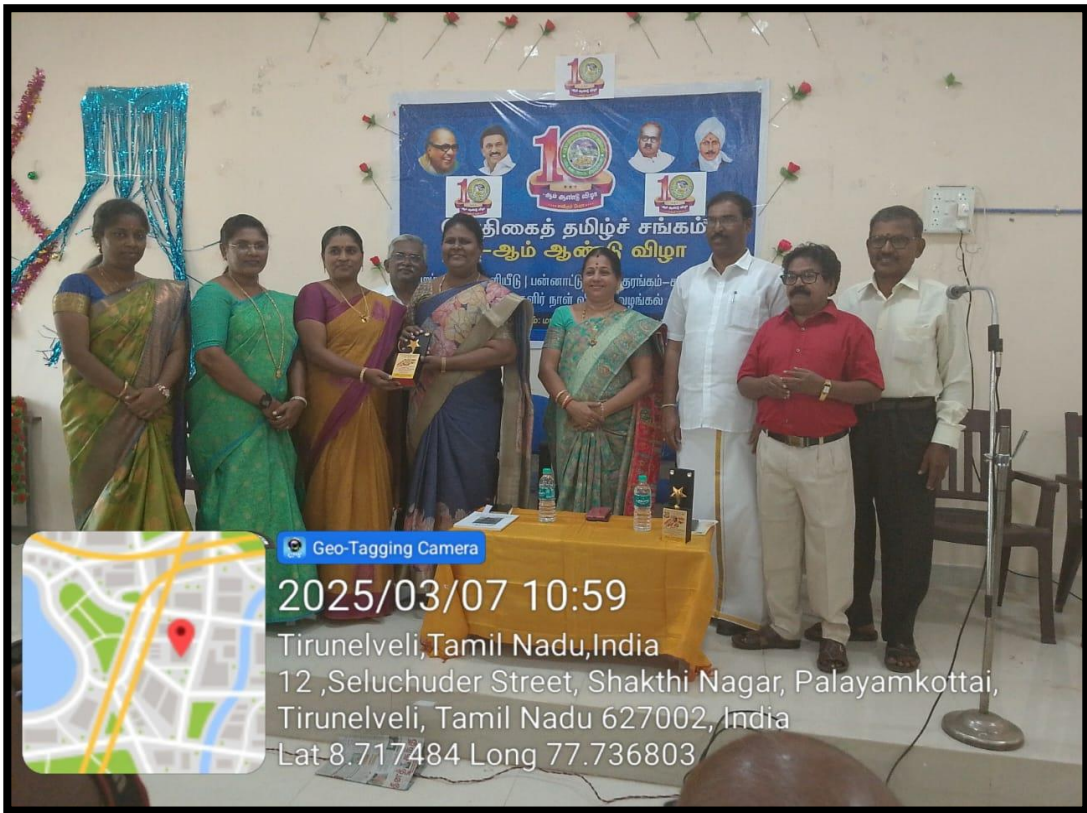

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Report on "An Exposure to International Seminar and Kaviyarangam"

7.03.2025

Rationale:

- To encourage students' involvement in cultural and academic activities, promote the Tamil language and literature, and enhance students' academic and creative skills.
- To provide students with valuable exposure and learning experiences that would contribute to their intellectual and cultural growth.

Minutes:

The Sr. Lily Pushpam Library actively supported student participation in the International Seminar and Kaviyarangam organized by Podhigai Tamil Sangam, as part of the celebration marking the 10th anniversary of their Association. The event took place on 7th March 2025 at the District Central Library, Palayamkottai, and comprised two key segments:

International Seminar: The seminar focused on the theme "Bhartiyum Penniyamum" (Bharati and Feminism), where scholars presented research on the influence of Tamil poet Bharati in shaping feminist thought. Our student, Ms. Vanapetchiyammal, a First-Year Student Teacher, also served as a resource person in the seminar, presenting her paper on "Bhartiyum Penniyamum," sharing her insights into Bharati's contributions to feminist discourse in Tamil literature Kaviyarangam (Poetry Gathering): Students participated by reciting their own poems on the theme "Mahakaviyin Mathavam" (The End of Epic Poetry). Sr. Lily Pushpam College students actively took part in this segment, showcasing their creative literary works.
