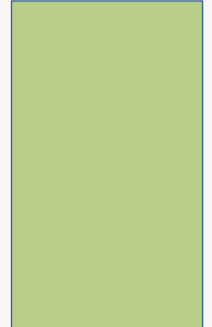

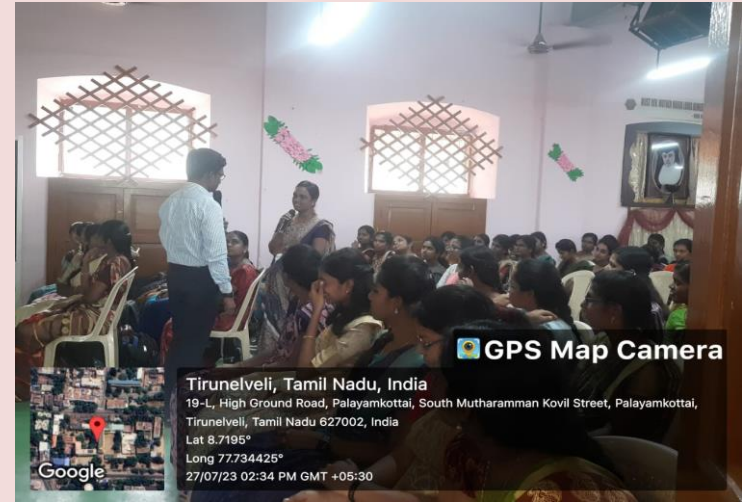
Read - Seed to Succeed
