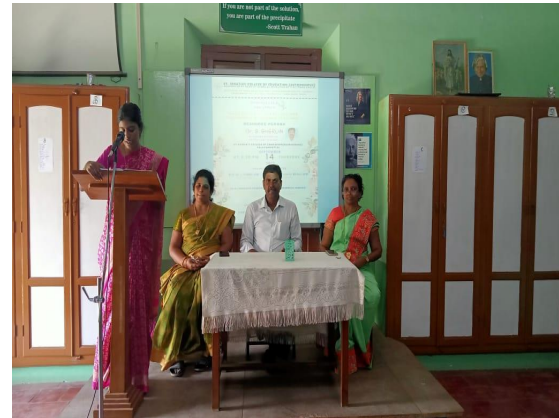
GLOBAL VISION TOWARDS AN ERA OF WOMEN
