# MICRO TEACHING COMPETENCY

The success of the teacher education programme depends on developing skills to identify different teaching objectives, attitude and patterns of teaching behaviour among the students. To improve the skills and abilities required for teaching, every year the students take part in the micro teaching cycle. Basically, the application of Micro-teaching is one of the efforts to develop the knowledge, skill and professional attitude of a teacher. Micro-Teaching allows the teacher to focus on the acquisition of teaching skills through the selection of only one standard of competence. Thus, it helps the teacher to reduce the complexity of teaching in the normal classroom. This year, it was held from 16.08.2017 to 30.08.2017.

Peer Teaching is an integral part of Micro +Teaching. Students sit in groups and everyone get their turn to teach. All the components of micro teaching skills are practiced one by one. Other members of the group observe and give their feedback. Incorporating the valuable input and feed back of the teacher educators, the student teachers gain expertise in teaching.



# INTENSIVE AND PRACTICE TEACHING

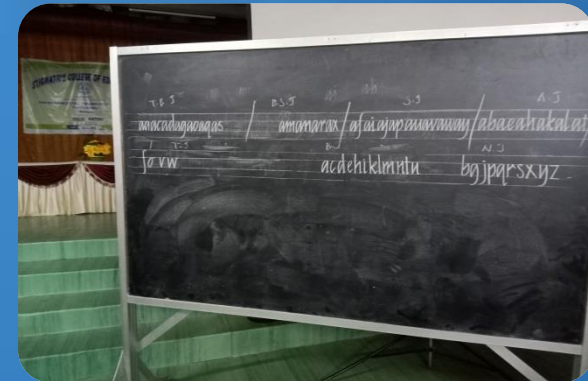
Every student knows that in this profession not to swim is to fall back. With this back drop the students were sent to the various supporting schools for the 4 months intensive teaching practice from 24<sup>th</sup> July 2017 to 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2017. Earlier the students had a 5 day preliminary teaching in St. Ignatius' Convent Higher Secondary School, Palayamkottai. I would like to place on record our sincere gratitude to Rev.Sr.Nirmala Louis, Headmistress, St.Ignatius convent Hr.Sec. School. In view of the practice teaching, our students had meaningful collaboration with senior teachers of the same school.

This year, our second year students were sent to 28 schools for Internship. It includes 8 Government schools, 16 Aided schools and 4 Private schools. Our faculty visited the schools periodically to guide our student teachers. They interacted with the Mentors allotted by the school management, to improve the efficacy of the budding teachers. Entire third semester is the period of Internship.
