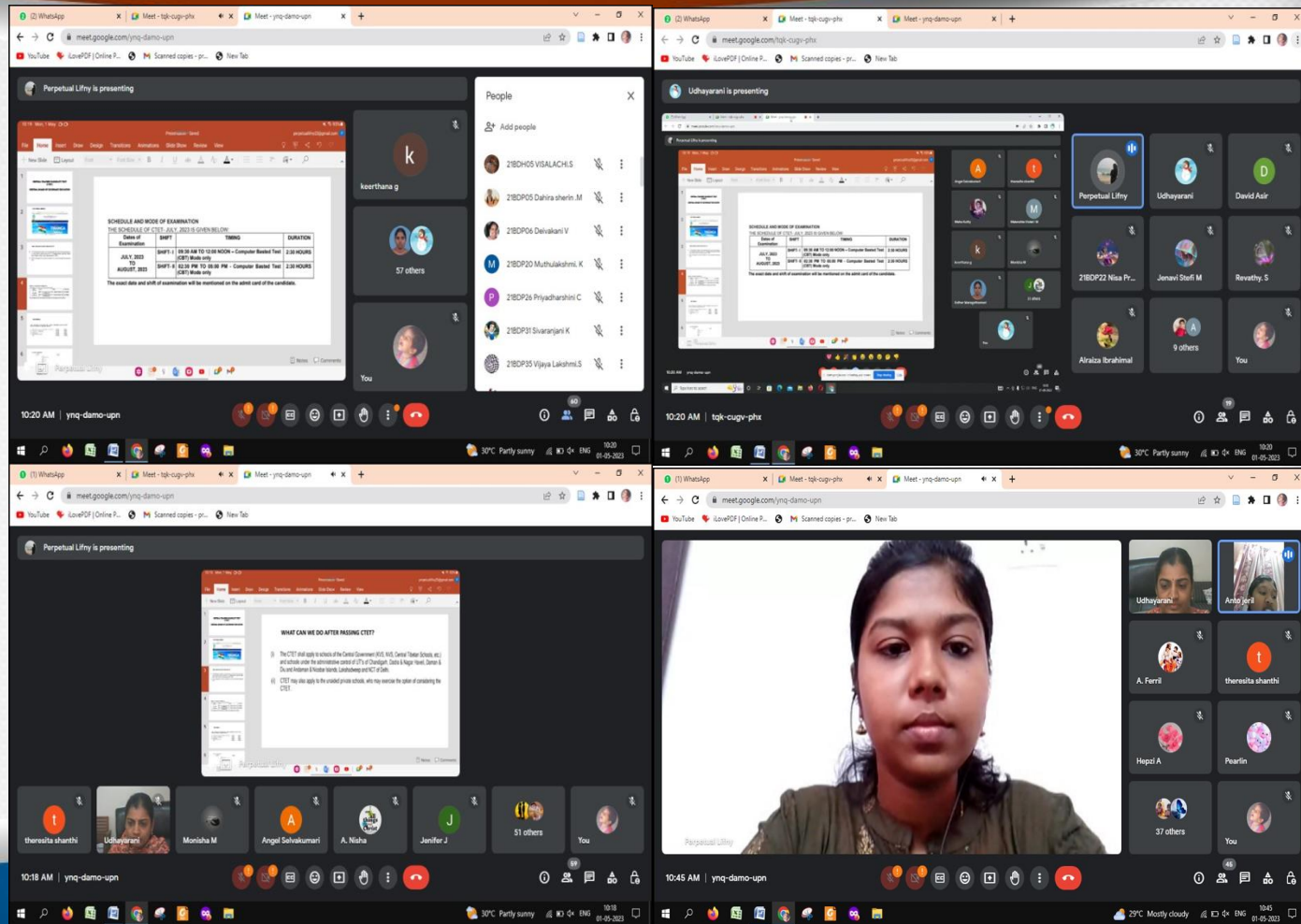

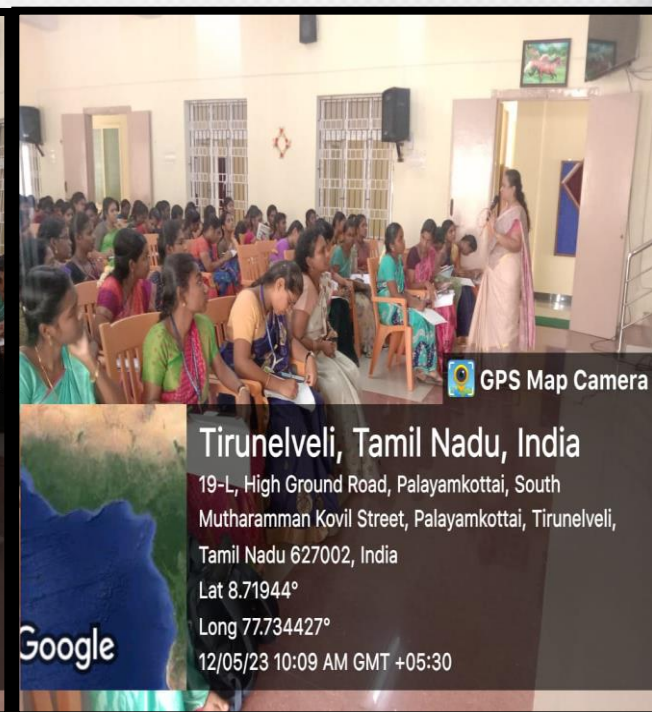
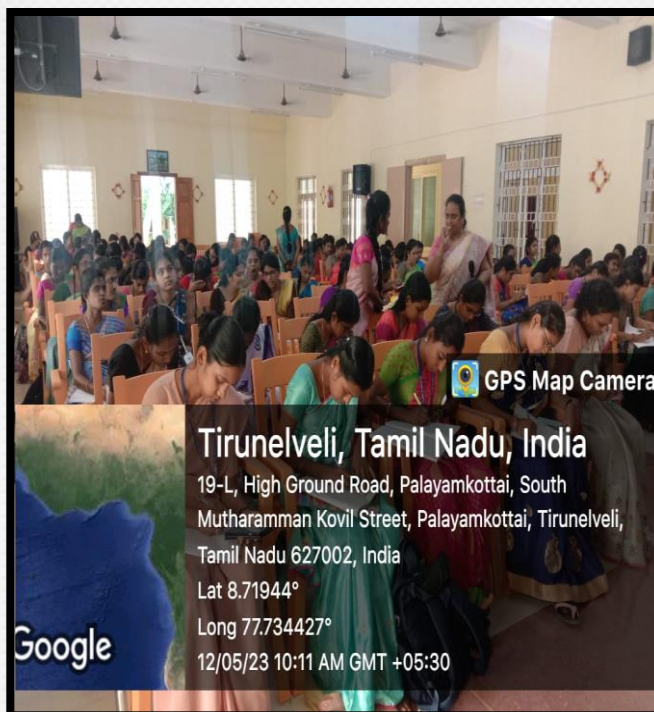
TEAM TEACHING: ESSENTIALS OF ASSESSMENT

Rawofu Nisha, Assistant Professor of Education, St. Ignatius College of Education, Palayamkottai, served as a resource person. She has highly focus on the Assessment Technics like Diagnostic, Criterion-Referenced, Norm-Referenced, Evidence Based, Formative, and Summative Assessment. She also explained the classroom Assessment strategies this session was very informative for our student teacher.



TEAM TEACHING IN THE COURSE "ASSIGNMENT OF LEARNING"

TEAM TEACHING ON EDUCATIONAL REFORMS AND ROLE OF ASSESSMENT

Team teaching was organized on Educational Reforms And Role Of Assessment on 10-05-2023. Ms. J. Rawoofu Nisha, Assistant Professor of Education served as the coordinator of the session. She gave a clear information about assessment in the pre-independent era, post-independence era and the Education Commissions. She focused on the importance of National policy on Education, National Curriculum Framework (2005), New Education policy 2020 and assessment. She highlighted, PARAKH, National Testing Agency and NAAC. She also explained how to prepare the 360 degree multidimensional assessment rank card.



TEAM TEACHING: ASSESSMENT APPROACHES & TECHNIQUES

St. Ignatius College of Education organized “Team Teaching: Assessment Approaches & Techniques” on 11.05.2023 at 9.30 a.m. The session started with prayer song. The resource person Ms.J.Rawofu Nisha, Assistant Professor of Education, St. Ignatius College of Education, Palayamkottai, has clearly explained about approaches to assessing student learning including formal or graded measures of assessment, and more informal, often ungraded, feedback opportunities. A holistic plan of assessment is sustainable, providing formative and summative feedback within the course, and providing learners with the skills to meet their future learning needs. She also explained that basic competency status assessment is done based on indicators of achievement of learning outcomes, either in the form of cognitive domains, effective, and psychomotor.



TEAM TEACHING ON LEARNING, LEARNING OUTCOME AND ASSESSMENT

The institution organized Team teaching on Learning, Learning Outcome and assessment on 09-05-2023. Ms. J. Rawoofu Nisha, Assistant Professor of Education served as the coordinator of the session. She articulated the importance learning outcome for quality education. She differentiated learning objectives and learning outcome. She highlighted the types of learning outcome and how it provides clear direction for educators when making instruction and assessment decisions. She explained the steps involved in constructing course learning outcome and assessment process.
