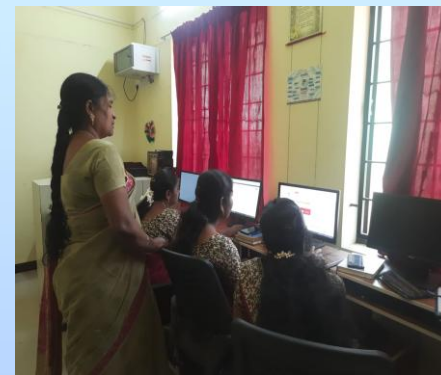
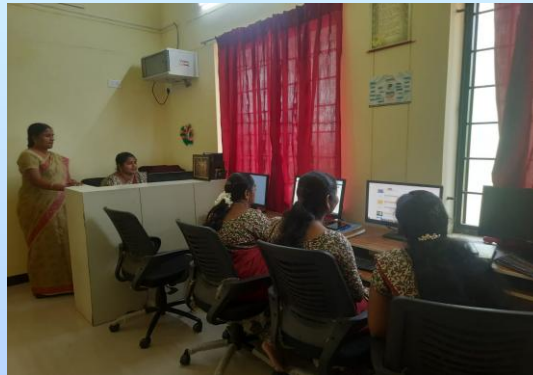
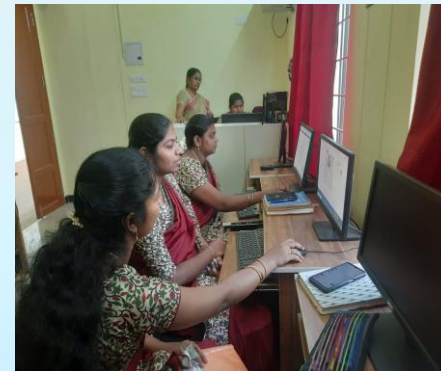
WORKSHOP ON BUILDING SELF-CONFIDENCE: PRACTICAL TIPS FOR OVERCOMING SELF-DOUBT-
