1.Ramp Facility

- Ramps are strategically installed across the campus to provide easy access to classrooms, administrative offices, and common areas.
- Designed with an appropriate gradient, these ramps ensure safe and smooth mobility for students using wheelchairs or walking aids.

2.Anti-Skid Floors

- Flooring throughout the campus is designed with anti-skid materials to prevent slips and falls, ensuring a safe movement experience for differently-abled students.
- This feature is especially beneficial in high-traffic areas such as corridors, stairways, and entrances.

3.Lift Facility

- A well-maintained elevator is available to facilitate seamless vertical mobility, allowing students with physical disabilities to access different floors without difficulty.

4. Accessible Toilets

- Specially designed restrooms for differently-abled students are available on campus, ensuring privacy, dignity, and ease of use.
